

## **Contact Lens Information Sheet**

## **New Contact Lens Wearers**

For new contact lens wearers there is a <b>\$150</b> fitting fee		
(\$	with your insurance coverage)	
due at th	e time of your contact lens training.	

**Initial Evaluation** | At the annual exam, the doctor will determine if the patient is a good candidate for contact lenses and which lenses are best based on the patient's prescription and lifestyle needs.

**Insertion & Removal Training** | Training on safe care, insertion, and removal of contact lenses. The patient will have up to three, one hour in-office training sessions. Upon successful completion of training, the patient will go home with contact lens trials to practice with and wear.

**One to Two Week Evaluation** | Patients will return to the office wearing contact lenses and the doctor will assess the lens fit and prescription. At this time, the doctor will either finalize the contact lens prescription or make necessary adjustments.

## **Existing Contact Lens Wearers**

For existing of	contact lens wearers there will be an <b>\$80</b> evaluation fee	
(\$	evaluation fee with your insurance coverage)	
due at the end of your visit.		

**Initial Evaluation** | At the annual exam, the patient will arrive wearing contact lenses and the doctor will evaluate the contact lens fit, vision and eye health. The doctor will update the prescription as needed and either finalize the prescription or will provide the patient with new contact lenses to test.

**One to Two Week Evaluation** | As needed, patients will return to the office to have lenses re-assessed, adjusted or finalize the prescription.

Once you have a finalized contact lens prescription, you will receive a copy of your contact lens prescription and you will also be able to purchase contact lenses at an additional cost. Cost varies.

The above fees do **NOT** include emergent contact lens appointments or medical office visits.



<u>Standard</u> contact lenses are spherical lenses that have the same lens power throughout the entire optical part of the lens.

Specialty/Premium lens types include astigmatism (toric), multifocal, and monovision.

Coverage may vary based on lens type. If you are unsure about which type of contact lens you wear feel free to ask us.

A contact lens is a <u>medical device</u> which requires ongoing care. Contact lens services may include:

- Review of lens wear time, replacement schedule, solutions, eye drops etc.
- Discussion and selection of the most appropriate lenses for your lifestyle and prescription.
- Measurements from your examination as well as corneal curvature to determine the best lenses for your eyes.
- Evaluation of vision with lenses on your eyes, adjustments to prescription where needed.
- An evaluation of the effects of contact lens wear on the health of the eye.
- 90 day follow-up with any non-emergent contact lens related care.
